District overview and demographics

Our District was created in 1984/1985, it groups the countries of Tunisia, Algeria, Morocco and Mauritania. Nowadays our district groups 114 Rotary clubs and 1890 Rotarians and as for Rotaract we have 78 clubs with 2150 Rotaractors.

The main activities our district is actively doing are:

- Increasing and rejuvenating membership;
- Participating in RI efforts to eradicate polio;
- Hosting the Rotary African Summit.



National Coordination of Rotaract Tunisia

1- History

The National Coordination of Rotaract Tunisia (CNRT) is a national entity that gathers all Rotaract clubs in Tunisia.

Created in 2008, the National Coordination was founded to meet the need of gathering Tunisian Rotaract members to cooperate and work together. Clubs appoint their representatives within the National Coordination to facilitate communication and cooperation in local humanitarian projects, trainings, national gatherings, and international collaborations.

2- Members

The National Coordination of Rotaract Tunisia started with 10 clubs only about 200 members but today, it consists of 51 charted clubs and more than 1600 members.

The CNRT have a board of directors like any regular club composed of:

- President;
- Vice-president;
- Secretary;
- Treasurer;
- Sergeant-at-arms.

And also have committees to better organize its projects. These committees are:

- The international committee;
- The fellowship committee;
- The professional and personal development committee;
- The communication and public image committee;
- The digitizing committee.

3- Activities

The National Coordination of Rotaract Tunisia is similar to MDIOs in its activities. It has no has no governing, decision-making, or legislative powers, except for decisions concerning the activities of this organization.

The main activities of the CNRT are:

- Organizing a national meeting once a month;
- Organizing one humanitarian project once a year;
- Organizing one training weekend every year and helping in organizing the Rotaract training seminar with district officials;
- Organizing a fellowship weekend once a year.

What did we do before?

It may seem that Rotaract Tunisia has no experience when it comes to hosting large or international events. In fact, we're used to this kind of activities and our last successful event was the Rotaract Mediterranean Meeting M2R. We've also organized many of our district conferences along with other national events such as the "Dating".

1- M2R

We, Rotaract Tunisia, had the honor to host the 7th edition of the Rotaract Mediterranean meeting-M2R for the first time in Tunisia, from 02 to 08 September 2019 in Hammamet, Sousse, and Tunis. Our goal was to bring like-minded people together, mainly Rotaractors from the Mediterranean region, to discover the beauty of Tunisia and bring international understanding to the world. After months of hard work and preparation, our m2r was deemed a true success. Rotaractors from 9 countries were present and they all collaborated along with the host organizing committee and the national coordination of Rotaract Tunisia to have as much fun as possible. The Rotaract Mediterranean Meeting - Tunisia 2019 featured different kinds of activities to provide our participants with a pleasant experience and showcase the different charms Tunisia has to offer ranging from culinary delights to historical gems.

2- District Youth Conference

As previously mentioned in earlier sections, our district is a little particular since it groups four countries. Each year, the District Youth conference is held in one of the district countries and when it is in Tunisia, the CNRT collaborates with the DG and DRR to organize it. The last DYC organized in Tunisia took place in March 2017. The DYC consists of gathering Rotaractors from Tunisia, Algeria and Morocco (unfortunately Mauritania has no active Rotaract clubs) to participate in several interesting workshops, general assembly of the district and team building activities. Usually, the DYC is preceded by a two or three-days program full of sightseeing and fun activities

3- Dating

The dating is one of the most awaited events for Tunisian Rotaractors. We usually have between 600 and 800 participants and the registration is closed in no more than 5 minutes. The dating gathers Rotaractors from all clubs in Tunisia to participate in workshops and team building activities, to get know different clubs and new Rotaractors as well as to have fun after a semester full of community services projects.

Government support letters

To successfully organize and host an event of the magnitude of Interota, we're going to need the support of the key ministries and that is why we solicited different ministries.

We spoke with the ministry of interior, tourism and culture and they all agreed on supporting us in our efforts by helping us. Unfortunately, we could get any signed official documents because we just had our elections and the ministries were busy in the transition phase.
